

A.M.A.D.E. - ORDER of MALTA

The Amade (World Association of Children's Friends) founded in 1963 with offices in 19 countries whose President is H.R.H. Princess Caroline of Hanover, promotes measures to fight the distress of childhood. It is a non governmental organization accredited to Unesco, Unicef and the Council of Europe. Founded in 1974, the aim of the Monegasque Association of the Sovereign Order of Malta, whose Honorary President is H.S.H. Prince Albert II of Monaco, is to expand humanitarian activities and to redistribute surplus medicines to the poorest countries in the world. Working often together, the two organizations are financing the construction of elementary schools, care units, first aid and welfare centers and are helping local associations particularly in Africa.
